

## **TOXOCARA CANIS, TOXOCARA CATI, TOXOCARA LEONINA**

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Toxocariasis (Larva Migrans Visceralis) is a zoonosis extremely common on globe. It is determined by the migration of *Toxocara Canis* and *Toxocara Cati* larvae form in liver, lungs, myocardium and rarely in eye and brain. Usually the symptoms are: general malaise, fever, eosinophilia and leukocytosis. The positive and differential diagnosis is hard to establish by clinicians and raise many problems which could delay the anti-parasitic treatment, evolution, in this case, could be undetermined. The surveillance and control of this geohelminthiasis needs measures against reservoirs, modes of transmittion and measures of protection for the susceptible population.

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
